ORDER 2009-36

AN ORDER DENYING CHRISTOPHER OJAN'S APPLICATION FOR OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE

The Commission has considered the following factors:

On October 15, 2007, Christopher Ojan applied for a level 2 occupational license to work as a surveillance technician at Argosy Casino. He did not disclose a 2004 marijuana charge in his application for occupational license. On October 15, 2008, Mr. Ojan was issued a temporary occupational license. After investigating his application for occupational license and providing him several opportunities to remedy his failure to disclose, Commission staff determined that Mr. Ojan was not suitable for licensure due to his repeated violations of 68 IAC 2-3-5(b)(9). On June 3, 2008, Commission staff revoked Mr. Ojan's temporary license and notified him that his application would be denied at an upcoming Commission meeting unless he withdrew his application or corrected his failure to disclose. He did not withdraw his application and did not correct his failure to disclose.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby DENIES Christopher Ojan's Application for Permanent Occupational License.
