## ORDER 2009-37 APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT RE: RONNIE ALLEN

In October 2008, Commission staff received case reports filed by Agent David Panak regarding an investigation into several instances of failure to appropriately enter an electronic gaming device. According to this report, Commission staff determined that Mr. Ronnie Allen failed to insert his employee card into these electronic gaming devices and failed to complete the Machine Entry Authorization Log, in violation of 68 IAC 2-6-1. After reviewing the evidence, on December 9, 2008, Commission staff mailed Mr. Allen a letter regarding possible disciplinary action against him for failure to comply with Commission regulations.

Subsequently, Commission staff and Mr. Allen agreed on a settlement of this matter. The terms of the settlement agreement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide the following:

The above described actions of Licensee constitute a violation of Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code. The Commission and Licensee agree that a period of voluntary relinquishment of Licensee's occupational license shall be imposed on Licensee in full settlement of this violation. By agreement, Licensee's occupational license shall be voluntarily relinquished for three (3) working days at a time to be determined by the parties in cooperation with the Human Resources Department of Indiana Live. Licensee will not work his regularly scheduled shift as a Slot Technician at Indiana Live during this period of voluntary relinquishment. Licensee agrees that no vacation or paid leave time shall be used while serving his voluntary relinquishment.

## **COMMISSION ACTION**

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby APPROVES the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
