

ORDER 2011-130

**APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION AND MIXED MARTIAL ARTS
CONSULTING**

On or about October 12, 2011, Mixed Martial Arts Consulting ("Sanctioning Body") obtained from the Indiana Gaming Commission Promoter License # UB10000002. On March 26, 2011, Sanctioning Body provided oversight of an amateur unarmed combat event conducted by Chad's School of Mixed Martial Arts.

As required by LSA Document 11-168(E), Sections 5(b) and (c)(17), Sanctioning Body submitted to the Commission its policies for ensuring that no amateur mixed martial artist participates in an event while under suspension in the website registry certified and operated by the Association of Boxing Commissions ("ABC"). Under LSA Document 11-168(E), Section 5(g), failure of a sanctioning body to enforce those policies may result in disciplinary action against the sanctioning body.

Sanctioning Body allowed an amateur mixed martial artist who was under a medical suspension listed in the website registry certified and operated by the ABC to fight in the March 26, 2011 event.


On April 1, 2011, Commission staff sent a letter to Sanctioning Body regarding this matter. This letter offered to settle the matter in lieu of commission staff filing a complaint and pursuing disciplinary action.

Commission staff and Sanctioning Body have both agreed to settle this matter. The terms of the settlement agreement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, require Sanctioning Body to pay a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500).

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
