

ORDER 2011-242
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF A MINORITY OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN
LOTTOMATICA GROUP S.p.A. TO DEA PARTECIPAZIONI, S.p.A.

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following order pursuant to authority granted it under IC 4-33.

Lottomatica Group, S.p.A. ("Lottomatica") is licensed by the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") as a supplier. It provides gaming devices to Indiana casinos through its two wholly owned subsidiaries, Atronic Americas, LLC and Spielo Manufacturing, ULC. DeA Partecipazioni, S.p.A. ("Partecipazioni") has acquired a minority interest in Lottomatica from Lottomatica's parent company, De Agostini, S.p.A. Lottomatica will continue as a legal entity and will continue to hold the supplier license.

In addition to the above, the Commission has considered the following factors in contemplating the parties' request for approval of the transfer of ownership interest:

1. Lottomatica and Partecipazioni have submitted to the Commission transfer of ownership applications and personal disclosure forms for all Substantial Owners and Key Persons as deemed necessary by Commission staff.
2. The Commission's Background and Financial Investigations sections have completed a comprehensive investigation of Partecipazioni. Commission staff has presented a confidential final investigative report of Partecipazioni and its Key Persons to the Commission for review.
3. Partecipazioni has presented sufficient evidence that it meets or possesses the standards, qualifications, and criteria necessary to be issued a supplier's license pursuant to 68 IAC 2-2-5, 68 IAC 5-1-2(d), and IC 4-33-7.


COMMISSION ACTION

Based on the foregoing, and in accordance with 68 IAC 5-1, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the transfer of a minority ownership interest in Lottomatica to Partecipazioni.

The Commission's approval is contingent upon acceptance of the continuing condition that Lottomatica, Partecipazioni, and all relevant affiliates, Key Persons, and Substantial Owners remain in full compliance with all laws, regulations and/or other directives which are applicable to this acquisition, and/or to a supplier licensee in the State of Indiana.


