

**ORDER 2013-198**  
**APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INDIANA**  
**GAMING COMMISSION AND LOIS COYLE-DUFFY**

On or about May 28, 2009, Lois Coyle-Duffy (“Coyle-Duffy”) received a level 1 permanent occupational license to work at Indiana Grand Casino in Shelbyville, Indiana as Director of Surveillance. In May 2013, Coyle-Duffy submitted a reinvestigation application to the Commission in order to renew the Level 1 occupational license. During the background investigation of the reinvestigation application, Commission investigators determined she had failed to comply with her continuing duty to maintain suitability for licensure. 68 IAC 2-3-9(a).

Commission staff and Coyle-Duffy have agreed to settle this matter in lieu of Commission staff filing a complaint and pursuing disciplinary action. The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Coyle-Duffy shall pay a monetary fine in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) to the Commission.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
