

**ORDER 2014-45**

**RATIFYING THE PREVIOUSLY ISSUED ORDERS IN 2014-HP-03**

Commission Resolution 2012-151 allows the Executive Director, upon obtaining consent from one Commissioner, to exercise the powers and duties of the Commission under IC 4-35-4-1.

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. The Commission may take action, including, but not limited to, revocation, suspension, or restriction of an occupational license at any time that the Commission determines the occupational licensee is in violation of IC 4-35 or 68 IAC 2. 68 IAC 4-35-6.5-8.
2. The Commission may suspend an occupational license without notice or an evidentiary proceeding, by an authorized individual or panel of individuals. 68 IAC 13-1-22.
3. On January 23, 2014, Executive Director Yelton, upon obtaining concurrence from a Commissioner, issued Order 2014-HP-03, under Indiana Code 4-21.5-4, 68 IAC 13-1-22, and Resolution 2012-151.
4. Order 2014-HP-03 found that a current Level 2 licensee was unsuitable for licensure, and that it was in the best interests of the public and the gaming industry to suspend the level 2 licensee's license immediately. On February 4, 2014, Order 2014-HP-03 reinstated the level 2 licensee's license following the removal of the suitability impediment.
5. Resolution 2012-151 requires that the Executive Director must report any action taken under Resolution 2012-151 to the Commission for ratification or other action by the Commission.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby **RATIFIES** the Executive Director's January 23, 2014 and February 4, 2014 orders in matter number 2014-HP-03.
