

ORDER 2014-89
APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INDIANA
GAMING COMMISSION AND SUZANA SIMIC

On or about November 13, 2013, Suzana Simic (“Ms. Simic”) received a level 2 temporary license and temporary identification badge to work at Horseshoe Hammond Casino as a dealer. During a background investigation, Commission investigators determined additional information from Ms. Simic was necessary. A Commission investigator gave Ms. Simic a chance to provide the necessary information via a letter she received on December 18, 2013, with a thirty (30) day deadline to respond. Ms. Simic failed to respond in any way and failed to provide the requested information.

An applicant for occupational license must comply with all requests for information, documents, or other materials relating to the applicant and her application during the investigation conducted by the Commission. 68 IAC 2-3-5(b)(9).

Commission staff and Ms. Simic have agreed to settle this matter in lieu of Commission staff pursuing disciplinary action. The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Ms. Simic will voluntarily relinquish her temporary license and temporary identification badge for a period of three (3) unpaid regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation or any other paid leave time; and agrees to the placement of her temporary license and temporary identification badge on probation status for a period of six (6) months or longer at the Commission’s sole discretion.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.


