ORDER 2015-144 AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH JAMES ROBINSON

James Robinson (Mr. Robinson) has held a Level 2 occupational license since May 6, 1996 at several Indiana casinos and is currently employed by Blue Chip Casino. On February 18, 2015, Mr. Robinson submitted a Level 1 occupational license application. During the background investigation, Commission investigators discovered Mr. Robinson failed to comply with federal and state tax laws and participated in online gambling. Mr. Robinson's actions violate 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 2-3-9 by failing to maintain suitability.

In lieu of disciplinary proceedings, Commission staff and Mr. Robinson have agreed to settle this matter. The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Mr. Robinson agrees to an unpaid voluntarily relinquishment of his occupational license and identification badge for a period of five regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation or any other paid leave time.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby <u>APPROVES</u> the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
