## **ORDER 2018-195**

## AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING WILLIAM DEHAVEN, JR.'S PLACEMENT ON THE STATEWIDE EXCLUSION LIST

On August 26, 2017, while at the Indiana Grand Casino in Shelbyville, Indiana, William Dehaven, Jr. ("Dehaven") insistently refused to return a jackpot payout that was erroneously paid to him, which ultimately resulted in him being transported to the Shelby County jail. Pursuant to 68 IAC 6-1-3, Dehaven was placed on the statewide exclusion list on November 8, 2017, effectively and permanently barring him from entering any casino in Indiana.

On November 30, 2017, Dehaven timely filed an appeal of his placement on the statewide exclusion list with the Commission. Administrative Law Donald L. Hannah was assigned to the case. After the Commission filed a motion for summary judgment and Dehaven, through counsel, filed a response, the Administrative Law Judge issued an Order granting summary judgment in favor of the Commission, which affirmed Dehaven's placement on the statewide exclusion list.

On October 18, 2018, Dehaven, through counsel, timely objected to the Administrative Law Judge's Order.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

## **AFFIRMS**

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. By affirming the Order, the Commission hereby incorporates the findings of fact and conclusions of law in the Administrative Law Judge's Order. This is a final Order of the Commission.
