
Dear Executive Director Tait,

Please allow this letter to serve as the notice of intent pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-33- 24-16 of StarStreet, Inc (d/b/a Draft) to submit an application to conduct paid fantasy sports in Indiana. This notice of intent will allow StarStreet, Inc (d/b/a Draft) to operate in Indiana during the application period as it was in operation in Indiana on March 31, 2016. StarStreet, Inc (d/b/a Draft) understands that by applying to be an operator in Indiana it is obligated to comply with statutes, administrative rules, emergency rules, and directives as proscribed by the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”). We understand that any company offering paid fantasy sports in Indiana that does not file an application by the established deadline will no longer be authorized to lawfully conduct the activity pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-33-24.
