

Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Program

The Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) program is HUD funding to provide housing assistance and related supportive services for low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families. \$463,791 has been awarded to the state of Indiana. \$232,202 was awarded to the City of Indianapolis and \$231,589 to Indiana Nonentitlement (non-urban communities) for IHCDA to administer for the balance of the state (below).
