The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have completed our review of the documents necessary to make an air quality conformity finding for the Michiana Area Council of Government's (MACOG) planning documents. The South Bend-Elkhart Planning Area is within the MACOG air quality conformity area comprised of St. Joseph and Elkhart Counties. The need for this new conformity finding stems from a recent update to the MACOG 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).

St. Joseph and Elkhart Counties are designated as Maintenance for the 1997 Ozone Standard until July 19, 2027.

Appropriate consultation and public involvement on the 2050 MTP document was completed. The Indiana Department of Environmental Management, the Indiana Department of Transportation, and the US Environmental Protection Agency have completed their reviews and have determined that air quality conformity requirements have been met.

This conformity determination letter supersedes all previous conformity determination letters for this MPO. Therefore, FHWA and FTA affirms the following planning documents conform to air quality conformity rule requirements:

RESOLUTION 02-24 A RESOLUTION ENDORSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SOUTH BEND AND ELKHART/GOSHEN FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2024-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) (Public Law 117-58, also known as the "Bipartisan Infrastructure Law") designating joint Federal Highway Administration/Federal Transit Administration rules and regulations, under Section 134, Title 23 of the US Code, the act requires the annual preparation of a Transportation Improvement Program by the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization(s) as a part of the transportation planning process in urbanized areas of 50,000 or more population; and
- WHEREAS, the Michiana Area Council of Governments (MACOG) being the duly designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the South Bend and Elkhart/Goshen Urbanized Areas, in cooperation with local governmental units and implementing agencies within the urbanized areas, has prepared a FY 2024-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) which consist of improvements recommended in the MACOG Region.
- WHEREAS, the FY 2024-2028 TIP is consistent with the 2050 Transportation Plan (TP) and its corresponding conformity determination, which uses the MACOG travel demand model, developed with the most recently available socio-economic and other input data to estimate mobile source emissions for the conformity analysis.
- WHEREAS, the MACOG Policy Board from time to time receives and amends/modifies its Transportation Improvement Program.
- WHEREAS, upon review of the amendments below, MACOG here within finds that they are consistent with the 2050 TP and its corresponding conformity analysis.
- BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the South Bend and Elkhart/Goshen FY 2024-2028 TIP will be amended to include the following:
