

FACTS:

Stephen Priem was employed by the Goshen Police Department January 1, 1985. When he went through the physical examination required for membership in the 1977 Police and Firefighters' Pension and



An initial determination letter of June 26, 1985 from L. H. Earle, II, Executive Secretary of the Public Employees' Retirement Fund, denied membership in the 1977 Fund as a result of Mr. Priem's failure to pass

The Goshen Police Pension Fund has appealed.

FINDINGS:

Indiana Code 36-8-8-7 reads in part:

- "(a) Except as provided in subsections (d), (e), and (f) of this section:
 - (1) a police officer who has not reached his thirty-six birthday; or
 - (2) a firefighter who has not reached his thirty-sixth birthday;

who passes a physical examination and mental examination prescribed by the local board under section 19 of this chapter is a member of the 1977 Fund and is not a member of another pension fund.

Indiana Code 36-8-8-19 reads in part:

- "(a) The physical examination required by section 7(a) of this chapter shall be administered by a licensed physician and must include a general medical history and at least the following physical examinations:
- (1) Visual testing by Snellen Chart
- (2) Pulmonary function test
- (3) Chest x-ray (posterior-anterior and lateral views)
- (4) Lumbosacral spine x-rays (anterior-posterior, lateral, and oblique views)
- (5) Treadmill test
- (6) Twelve (12) lead E.C.G.
- (7) Urinalysis
- (8) V.D.R.L. test
- (9) Audiometric test
- (10) "Profile 4" tests from which liver, kidney, blood and matabolic tests may be detected.

The PERF Board shall adopt minimum standards by rule under IC 4-22-2 that a police officer or firefighter must meet for the physical examination.

- (b) The mental examination required by section 7(a) of this chapter shall be administered by a licensed physician or a licensed psychologist, who shall determine if the police officer or firefighter is mentally suitable to be a member of the department.
- (c) The employer shall pay for no less than one-half (1/2) the cost of the examinations.
- (d) Each local board shall name the physicians and psychologists who will conduct examinations under this section.
- (e) If a police officer or firefighter passes the physical and mental examinations and becomes a member of the department, copies of the results of the examinations shall be sent to the PERF Board, which shall retain them until the police officer of firefighter is found to be disabled, retires, or separates from the department. As added by P.L. 365-1983, SEC. 2."

35 IAC 2-11.3 reads in part:

As determined by the physician's examination of the applicant, the following conditions will result in rejection of the applicant except as otherwise indicated:





DECISION AND CONCLUSION OF LAW:

Based on the evidence and testimony presented, and in view of the above facts and findings, I, Burton L. Garten, duly appointed hearing officer for the State Board of the Public Employees' Retirement Fund, would recommend the denial of membership to Stephen Priem in the 1977 Police and Firefighters' Pension and Disability Fund pursuant to IC 36-8-8-7, IC 36-8-8-19, and 35 IAC 2-1.1-3.
