Next Steps

- Moving from design mode to operational mode. Discussion took place over possible ways; one way is with a demand/supply analysis. Flexibility and nimbleness are words to describe how the system needs to be. How does the Council ensure there is capacity to deliver? Have to ensure capacity to deliver but cannot be duplicative. Business interaction with younger grades was also discussed.
