## **What to Bring to Your WIC Certification Appointment**

1. Each person who is applying for WIC
2. A parent, guardian or caretaker of an infant, child, or woman under 18 years old who is applying for WIC
3. **Proof of Income**

Income documents for everybody in your family who works or has a source of income.

For example:

- Paycheck stub(s) for the past 30 days, if paid biweekly bring 2 pay stubs or if paid weekly bring 4 pay stubs
- A letter from your employer or
- You may be automatically income eligible if you or certain family members participate in the following programs: Medicaid, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), or Food Stamps. **A letter of eligibility is needed.**

4. **Proof of Identity**

For example:

- A driver's license,
- A photo ID, or
- A birth certificate

5. **Proof of Address**

For example:

- A bill or business letter addressed to you,
- A rent receipt, or
- A current driver's license
