Commission to Issue Order on BlueIndy Project

What: The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) will issue its order in Cause No. 44478, a petition from Indianapolis Power and Light for an alternative regulatory plan for the extension of distribution and service lines and installation of facilities associated with the BlueIndy electric vehicle sharing program.
