Dear Mr. Asberry:

Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-28, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("IURC") received the comments of the Indiana Economic Development Corporation ("IEDC") regarding the rule proposed by the IURC in LSA No. 09-790, adding 170 IAC 15 to establish sub-billing procedures for water and sewage disposal service.

The IEDC's Comments were received on December 29, 2009, which is at least seven (7) days prior to the Public Hearing scheduled in this matter for Tuesday, January 5, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. local time.

The IURC understands that the IEDC has no objection to the economic impact associated with this proposed rule and has no suggested alternatives or changes to this proposed rule. In addition, the IEDC recognized that the proposed rule will result in no increased cost to small businesses and that compliance with the proposed rule is voluntary. Further, the IEDC recognized the proposed rule could potentially result in decreased costs to landlords by clarifying the means by which a landlord can be classified outside the definition of a "public utility," thus eliminating annual public utility fees for sewage disposal and water.
