The Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor thanks the Commission for inviting informal comments and suggestions from interested parties concerning the Commission's draft proposed revisions to its telecommunications rules, currently being considered in RM 09-10 and RM 09-11. The OUCC submits this e-mail as its preliminary, informal feedback on the draft proposal.

Based upon the OUCC's initial review, it respectfully suggests that it would be beneficial for the Commission to conduct one or more workshops before finalizing language for proposed revisions to its telecom rules. The OUCC is a proponent of a more robust discussion of the language the Commission will ultimately propose in RM 09-10 and RM 09-11. The OUCC would welcome the opportunity to discuss the draft proposal with Commission staff and other interested parties to attempt to address questions, resolve open issues and hopefully avoid later objections to (and delays in implementing) new telecom rules consistent with P.L. 26-2007 (a/k/a HEA 1279).
