Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-28, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("IURC") received the comments of the Indiana Economic Development Corporation ("IEDC") regarding the rule proposed by the IURC in LSA Document #10-478, adding 170 IAC 7-8 to establish the Indiana Lifeline Assistance Program. The IEDC's Comments were received on May 6, 2011, which is more than seven (7) days prior to the Public Hearing scheduled in this matter for Monday, May 16, 2011, at 1:30 p.m. E.D.T.

The IURC understands that the IEDC has no objection to the economic impact associated with this proposed rule. In addition, the IEDC recognized that costs for administration and for consumer education and outreach are reimbursable and, therefore, it is estimated that there will be only a nominal cost to small businesses affected by this rule.
