Biographical Note

Lowell Nussbaum, born on November 6, 1901, was a professional journalist whose "The Things I Hear" column ran in *The Indianapolis Star* newspaper from 1945 to 1971. He worked at the *Indianapolis Times* in 1938 as a special assignment reporter and columnist and remained with them until 1945. He then worked for the *Indianapolis Star* as a columnist and worked there until his retirement in 1971. He was inducted into the Indiana Journalism Hall of Fame during his lifetime.

This collection includes photographs and postcards from Lowell Nussbaum in Indianapolis, Indiana ranging from circa 1910-1930s regarding Indianapolis buildings, street scenes and surrounding Indiana cities.
