A story, "Freak Legislation Enacted in Earnest," by Arthur B. Reeve was published in *The Scrap Book* in June 1911.

Scope and Contents

This article is entitled: "Freak Legislation Enacted in Earnest with Fifty National, State, Territorial, and Colonial Lawmaking Bodies Active, It Is No Wonder the Output Is Peculiar." The headings include: "Getting After Long Hat Pins," "Penalizing the Hobble-Skirt," "Gossip and Flirting Tabooed," "Good Bills Which Sound Foolish," "A Fine for the Newly-Weds," and "His Sanity Was Questioned" (Brooklyn Congressman introduced a bill to completely reorganize the U.S. government). The printed article begins on page 1029 and concludes on page 1035.
