Vella F. Good was born November 24, 1887 in Clinton County, Indiana to George M. and Florida Rogers Good, one of five children. She worked at Clinton County Bank for more than 45 years. She was a member of the Business and Professional Women's Club and Daughters of the American Revolution. She died April 23, 1973 and is buried in the Green Lawn Cemetery in Frankfort, Indiana.
