


STATEWIDE SERVICES



Library Development Office (LDO)

•The Library Development Office supports the improvement and development of library services to all Indiana citizens including:

- INSPIRE.in.gov
- Indiana Memory
- Hoosier State Chronicles
- InfoExpress

•Includes consultants in the areas of library finance, management, planning, evaluation, grants, board training, trustees, ERate, expansion, library standards, certification, statistics, new director information, PLAC information, and unserved communities

•Administers statewide library services like INfoExpress Library Courier Service, LSTA Grants, digitization projects, and the Read-To-Me Project

Professional Development Office (PDO)

•The Professional Development Office supports the advancement and development of library staff in all Indiana libraries for improved services to the citizens of Indiana

•Includes specialists in the areas of programming, children's services, continuing education opportunities and services available from the Indiana State Library including book club kits for youth, LEGO kits, and story time kits

•Regional Coordinators, with expertise in library services, are available for every library in the state

•Trainings on a variety of library related topics for staff development

•Leadership Academy through the Indiana State Library Professional Development Committee
