New state library children's consultant

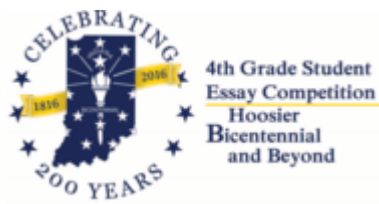

Library Development Office and Indianapolis Public Library team up for booksale and workshops

Several times throughout the year, the Indianapolis Public Library (IPL) holds a public book sale to dispose of duplicate, discarded or unneeded materials from their collection. On the Monday following the public sale the library offers the remainder of the collection to nonprofit organizations, including libraries and correctional facilities.

Twice each year, in April and November, on the nonprofit day, the Indiana State Library's (ISL) Library Development Office (LDO) offers interlibrary loan workshops for the public, private school and institutional libraries it supports with its outreach services, such as IN-SHARE and InfoExpress. Topics covered during these sessions include IN-SHARE, InfoExpress, effective use of Book Club requests and SRCS, Indiana's new Statewide Remote Circulation Service, which allows users to search a statewide catalog of over 30 million items and request to have them delivered to their home library. Additionally, ISL staff are on hand to bag up and prep the materials for shipping.

This year, on Nov. 21, 2016, ISL staff bagged and labeled 487 parcels, over-filling three 4' by 4' by 4' pallets. That equals roughly 10,000 free books that were made available
