Mark Young set to leave IHCD A in August

[Mark Young](#) who currently serves as the Chief Operations Officer and Deputy Director will also be leaving IHCD A. Young, who joined IHCD A in 1998, has held various positions including the Housing and Community Development Manager, Rental Housing Compliance Manager, Assistant Compliance Manager, and Compliance Specialist. Mark, one of the longest tenured staff leaves IHCD A to begin his own consulting business.

Under their leadership, IHCD A underwent several operational and programmatic changes improving the agency's efficiency while creating a service-oriented environment. Highlights include overseeing IHCD A's homeownership opportunities which have seen over 14,000 Hoosiers become homeowners over the past seven years, the administration of \$1 billion in stimulus funding which created over 12,000 additional units of affordable housing options, and provided rapid re-housing assistance to nearly 3,000 residents who were either at imminent risk of or experiencing homelessness.
