Projects with an Environmental Assessment (EA) review level must contact all agencies listed below, unless specifically stated otherwise. In cases where additional contact was necessary or multiple comments were received list all dates of contact. When completing the ER portion of the application in GMS, list first date of contact and last date of comment if there are multiple dates.
