Compliance Director's Report

March 12, 2012

The Compliance Officers conducted a total of ninety-six (96) facility inspections during the month of February. Of those fifty-five (55) where Retail, thirteen (13) were HME/DME's, twenty-four (24) were CSR's, three (3) were Hospitals and one (1) Institutional inspection. The most common violations noted were expired medications, facsimile prescription noncompliance and the absence of posted pseudoephedrine limits. In addition, twenty-seven (27) investigations and or consumer complaints were filed and are being investigated.

A total of ten (10) armed robberies were reported. Four (4) of that number were located in Ft. Wayne. The following is a list of the type of controlled substances stolen:
