Mr. Lehmann stated that he has been licensed in the State of Indiana for at least 11 years and is currently self-employed.

The Committee discussed Mr. Lehmann's positive response to determine whether he was fit to continue to practice.

After discussion, a motion was made and seconded to renew Mr. Lehmann's on probation with the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Indefinite probation with and opportunity to withdrawal at the conclusion of his criminal probation.
- 2. Personal appearance at the October Committee meeting with a letter from his probation officer updating his status.
- 3. Notify the Board of any additional arrests
