Happy Nails – **DENIED** – Failed inspection, unsanitary implements, reusing disposable implements, unlicensed employees, no pets sign, facility license not displayed.

D'Elegance Barbershop LLC – **PROBATION** – Previously denied for failed inspection passed inspection this time, owner also had a Possession of Marijuana charge from 2011 all fines and sentencing complete.

Pandora TQM Unisex Beauty Salon – **PROBATION** – Previously denied for failed inspections, passed inspection this time.
