HEA 1269 - Board appointments: Provides for a four (4) year term with no term limits and no more than two members can come from the same congressional district. Members may be removed at the pleasure of the Governor. Criminal convictions will cause members to be removed from the board.

HEA 1245 - Emergency crimes rules are in effect until July 1, 2019, at which time the board may adopt them as a final rule.
