Re: CORE licensure test summary data for testing cycle 2015-16

Attached you will find an annual summary of CORE licensure test data for the 2015-16 testing cycle from 9/1/15 to 8/31/16. This data mirrors the summary data provided to the board in fall 2015, but for ease of comparison, data for 2014-15 is included on the spread sheet displaying statewide pass rates. There are three documents attached:

- A spread sheet showing data for initial licensure candidates enrolled in traditional educator
  preparation programs for 2014-15 and 2015-16. This spread sheet displays the number of test
  takers for each test, the mean total scaled score for each test and the statewide pass rates for
  candidates' first attempt and best attempt.
- 2. Interpretive and cautionary notes provided by the test vendor to assist in understanding the data.
- 3. A spread sheet displaying test data by institution for 2015-16. To prevent the identification of test scores to individuals, data is not displayed where the N size of test takers is less than 10.

Annual CORE test program summary data was requested by the board at the time the CORE tests were adopted in fall 2013. The phase-in of the CORE tests began in February 2014 and the first full testing cycle for the CORE tests was 2014-15.
