Re:	Special Education Child Count

Indiana Code 20-43-4-4 provides that the State Board shall monitor changes that occur in the number of students enrolled in programs for students with disabilities using two counts conducted in December and April of each school year.

This information is provided in the tables below. The first table lists the unduplicated special education Additional Pupil Count on April 3, 2017 taken from the DOE-SE and DOE-SV collections. The second table lists the special education Preschool Count on April 3, 2017 taken from the DOE-SE collection. Both tables provide comparisons of the totals between the April count and the count of December 1, 2016 conducted earlier in the 2016-17 school year.
