NEW FILING REQUIREMENTS FOR LIMITED PARTNERSHIPS AND LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIPS

Last Updated December 19, 2017

Effective January 1, 2018, all domestic and foreign limited partnerships (LPs) and limited liability partnerships (LLPs) will be required to file biennial reports with the Secretary of State's office. IC 23-0.5-1.5-11; IC 23-0.5-2-13. This new requirement makes LPs and LLPs consistent with the other entity types and helps to ensure that the Secretary of State's office has updated information on file for LPs and LLPs.

For all LPs and LLPs registered with the Secretary of State's office prior to January 1, 2018, the first biennial report will be due in the entity's formation or registration month in 2019 and in every odd year going forward.

All LPs and LLPs that register on or after January 1, 2018 will be required to file their biennial reports by the end of their month of registration every two years.

For example: ABC, LLP registers with the Secretary of State's office on January 21, 2018. Its first entity report will be due by January 31, 2020. It will then file a report by January 31 in every even year. If XYZ, LP registers with the Secretary of State's office on May 5, 2019, its first report will be due by May 31, 2021 and all subsequent reports will be due by May 31 in every odd year.

The fee for this report is \$50.00 if filed by paper or \$20.00 if filed electronically.
