

LEGAL NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION (8-22) Indiana Election Division (IC 3-10-8-1(3); IC 3-10-8-4)

INSTRUCTIONS: Each circuit court clerk who receives a writ ordering a special election must publish this legal notice in accordance with IC 5-3-1 at least twenty-one (21) days before the special election. A copy of the complete notice must be filed with the Indiana Election Division not later than noon, seven (7) days before the election.
