We're 22 not grandfathering the old form, we're just 23 approving a new form for 2010. The only changes 24

made were to include the beginning and ending

dates for the filing. 1 CHAIRMAN T. WHEELER: Which would be the May 4th, 2010 -- those dates as well; right? 3 MR. D. SIMMONS: Those dates and the signature line. 5 CHAIRMAN T. WHEELER: All those dates are 6 going to change, we have to change all the 7 dates, okay. 8 VICE CHAIR A. LONG: Move to approve CAN-4. 9 COMMISSIONER D. DUMEZICH: Second it. 10 CHAIRMAN T. WHEELER: Motion's made and 11 seconded, any further discussion? 12 (No response.) 13 CHAIRMAN T. CHAIRMAN T. WHEELER: Hold on, can we go to the CAN-34; what did you do there?

CHAIRMAN T. WHEELER: Same thing.

MR. D. SIMMONS: It's the same thing. We typically don't put filing dates because it's a dual purpose form, because if the school board candidates run in the primary, they run in the general election, and we just change the dates for that primary election to 2008.

CHAIRMAN T. WHEELER: So they can check the box and use the other one?

MR. D. SIMMONS: Check the box, and then we

change the signature line dates on the back for 1 the voter registration. 2 VICE CHAIR A. LONG: I move to approve 3 CAN-19, CAN-34, and Order 2009-310. COMMISSIONER D.
