

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO VOTERS

After you enter the polling place, state law requires you to **show a photo ID** before signing the poll list and casting a ballot. If you do not have your photo ID with you, you may still enter this polling place and vote by provisional ballot.

Your photo ID must meet the following requirements:

- 1. **Show your name**, which must conform to the name on your voter registration record (conform does NOT mean identical);
- 2. Show your photograph;
- 3. **Include an expiration date** indicating the document has not yet expired (or expired *after* November 8, 2022, the date of the last general election), except for certain military, Veterans and tribal IDs; and
- 4. Be issued by the United States, the State of Indiana, or a Native American Indian Tribe or band recognized by the U.S. Government.

NOTE: The address on your photo ID does NOT need to match the address on your voter registration record.
