

ORDER ON SHOW-CAUSE HEARING OF DECEMBER 10, 2024

A ~~show-cause~~ hearing was held on December 10, 2024. In addition to the undersigned, present at the hearing were Andrew Wignall, Prosecutor for the Indiana Alcohol and Tobacco Commission (IATC), and Ms. Kimberly Chew, court reporter. No one appeared at the hearing on behalf of Indiana Tap Mishawaka LLC ("Permittee") though they had been given proper notice of the hearing. Judicial notice was taken of the IATC's records including the Excise Incident Report for EX-23-021699, and the Orders of October 8, 2024, and November 12, 2024. Evidence was heard. Mr. Wignall then requested that the Permittee's alcohol permit, Permit #RR71-40556, be revoked per IAC 905-1-37-9(a), which request was GRANTED.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT a default judgment is hereby entered against INDIANA TAP MISHAWAKA LLC for I.C. 7.1-5-10-2, Dealing In Unauthorized Beverages, and PERMIT #RR71-40556 IS HEREBY REVOKED.
