Indiana Participates in National College Application Week, Sept. 23 - 27

High school seniors can apply to participating Indiana institutions for free

(INDIANAPOLIS) – The Indiana Commission for Higher Education (Commission) announces 30 Indiana colleges are participating in Indiana's College Application Week, September 23-27. During this week, students can apply to all participating colleges and universities for free. This annual effort encourages students to apply to Indiana colleges before early application deadlines, allowing students a greater chance of receiving institutionally-awarded financial aid.

College Application Week is part of <u>Learn More Indiana's</u> annual College GO! initiative that takes place each August through November with information and resources designed to help Hoosier K-12 students explore and plan for education beyond high school. The official kick-off to College GO! is the last full week in Sept. (23-27), coinciding with College Application Week. Today, Friday, Sept. 20, is #WhyApply Day, a social media campaign encouraging the public to share why it's important to apply to college.

"The Commission is excited to partner with colleges around the state to provide greater access to apply to a number of outstanding Indiana institutions," Commissioner for Higher Education Chris Lowery said. "College GO! continues to allow students of all ages to discover their path for continuing education after high school. We look forward to seeing Hoosier students take advantage of hundreds of dollars in waived application fees."
