2024 Student Advocates Conference Registration Open

Attendees will learn about important initiatives surrounding college completion from Commission staff

INDIANAPOLIS — Registration for the 2024 Student Advocates Conference is now <u>open</u>, the Indiana Commission for Higher Education (Commission) announced today. The conference will be held virtually on December 5, 2024. The Student Advocates Conferences brings together Indiana college and high school mentors, advisors, and other advocates to attend valuable educational sessions from Commission staff.

The theme of this year's conference is **Completion: Beyond Enrollment to Success.** Attendees will engage with Commission staff who lead agency efforts to increase the college completion rate throughout the state.

Education session topics include:

- Resources Supporting Adult Learner Attainment
- The Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship & Transition to Teaching Scholarship
- Expansion of the Indiana College Core
- Supporting Postsecondary Credential Completion
- Student Success Coaching: Increasing Degree Completion for 21st Century Scholars
- Outcomes-Based Performance Funding
- The College Completion Dashboard

"Indiana's focus on college completions has been bolstered by the Commission's programs and strategic initiatives," said Commissioner for Higher Education Chris Lowery. "We are continuing to find ways to improve on-time and extendedtime completion rates and have worked our way to be the 10th-best state in the country in this metric. This conference provides an opportunity to engage in discussion with higher education leaders about Indiana's completion rate, what we are doing about it, and how we can continue to move forward. The award will recognize one program or initiative focused on the Commission's key pillars of increasing the college-going rate, postsecondary completion and graduate retention for Hoosier students.
