We are working with Liz Manly at the University of Washington who is the consultant for innovation, and she spearheaded the mobile crisis in New Jersey. We are looking at how mobile crisis fits in with our youth as well as adults.

Parity: Steve McCaffrey

Still working closely with DOI. The studies take about two years. During our interim update, DOI informed us they are hopeful to have more detail information sometime in April 2022.

EBPs: Gabriela Rodriguez

Currently working to have the contract with DMHA and IU finalized. We plan to present to the commission on December 15th about MST. This will be up to eight sites around the state that will get the full training and full MST models.

Suicide/Gap Analysis: Jason Murray & David Berman

Since doing the analysis and the presentation the work group has been slow. Once we start looking at the 9-8-8 work, we will look at a new objective and gear toward that.

There have been 26 Indiana schools trained on suicide prevention.

Workforce Issues: Cathy Boggs & David Reed

The national council has put out recommendations regarding the workforce crisis. Our subcommittee will look over and speak about these recommendations to better help the workforce shortage issue.
