Brian Reed made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, Grover Bishop seconded. The motion carried unanimously.


ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS

Grover Bishop made a motion to adjourn, Brian Reed seconded. The motion carried unanimously.






Brian Reed, Vice President






