

CASS COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD PUBLIC HEARING
#108 Umbenhour Miller Open
Harrison and Noble Townships, Cass County
November 4, 2013

The Cass County Drainage Board held a Public Hearing #108 Umbenhour Miller Open, on November 4, 2013 at 2:30 p.m. in Room 203 of the Cass County Government Building. Those in attendance are members: Dave Arnold, Jim Sailors, Ralph Anderson, Attorney John Hillis, Surveyor Jenny Clark, and Secretary Cindy Howard.

Dave Arnold called the hearing to order.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT

The purpose of this hearing is to increase the maintenance assessment to be able to pay back the General Drain Improvement Fund and to fund future maintenance needs. Dave Arnold made a motion to adopt the report. Ralph Anderson 2nd; Motion carried unanimously. The report is on record in the Office of the Surveyor.

WRITTEN OBJECTIONS OR COMMENTS FILED

Written objections have been received from, Thomas L. Farrer and Alan Hanna.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Shannon Barr and Gene Barr of 3471 N. Royal Center Pike, Logansport, IN shared their concerns with the proposed rate of \$5.00 per acre assessment. Also, shared concerns with problems with the lower end of the ditch. There was discussion that this assessment is to help get the fund out of the red and to possibly start repairs at the bottom end of the ditch and work north as funds allow.

ACTIONS OF THE BOARD

Dave Arnold motioned to adopt the rate of \$5.00 per acre with a \$5.00 minimum for the 1st installment to start May 2014, the term to collect would be for 1 year only at this rate and then a maintenance rate of \$2.50 per acre per year with a \$5.00 minimum assessment to follow the 1 year only assessment. Ralph Anderson 2nd; Motion carried unanimously.

Jenny Clark read the legal notice of Findings and Order of the Board. Ralph Anderson made a motion to adopt the Findings and Order of the Board. Jim Sailors 2nd; Motion carried unanimously.
