

CASS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2017- 11

ORDINANCE CREATING FUND NO. 4109  
SHERIFF NON-REVERTING K-9 CARE, WELFARE AND TRAINING FUND

WHEREAS, the Cass County Sheriff has received a gift/contribution from a Cass County, Indiana citizen; and

WHEREAS, the express intent of the gift/contribution is that it be used for the care, welfare and training of K-9 (dogs), which animals are used by the Sheriff's Department to assist in carrying out the duties and responsibilities of the Sheriff and his deputies for the security and protection of the general public; and

WHEREAS, for the foregoing reason, it is necessary to create a non-reverting fund to deposit such gift/contribution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


The gift/contribution received by the Cass County Sheriff's Department, for the care, welfare and training of K-9 (dogs) to be utilized by the Sheriff to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the department, shall be deposited into a non-reverting account titled Fund No. 4109, Sheriff Non-Reverting K-9 Care, Welfare and Training Fund.

The account may be expended at the discretion of the Cass County Sheriff, for the care, welfare and training of its K-9 units or other expenditures authorized by the Cass County Council.

Expenditures made from Fund No. 4109, Sheriff Non-Reverting K-9 Care, Welfare and Training Fund shall be made by filing a claim to the Cass County Auditor with the intended use listed.


