ORDINANCE NO. 2024 -07

ESTABLISHING A NON-REVERTING FUND FOR COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT VAXCARE SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Cass County Health Department provides various services to the public, including providing vaccinations and immunizations;

WHEREAS, the Cass County Health Department has an agreement with VaxCare, LLC, wherein VaxCare provides inventory management and dispensing solution for vaccines;

WHEREAS, VaxCare, pursuant to the terms of the agreement, performs services to administer vaccines;

WHEREAS, Cass County Health Department has contracted with VaxCare to administer vaccines on behalf of VaxCare and in return received compensation for such services;

WHEREAS, the Cass County Health Department and the Cass County Council desire that the revenue generated from the VaxCare services be deposited into a Non-Reverting Fund (VaxCare Non-Reverting Fund 4111) which, in addition to any other money provided by the Cass County Council, will be utilized to purchase vaccines and other medications for the Health Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CASS COUNTY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This Ordinance creates Non-Reverting Fund (VaxCare Non-Reverting Fund 4111) for revenue received from fees charged for services provided by the Health Department on behalf of VaxCare to provide vaccinations and immunizations.
- 2. The money in the VaxCare Non-Reverting Fund 4111 shall remain in said fund until expended and shall not revert to the general fund at the end of the County's fiscal year.
- 3. The money in said Fund shall be used for the purchase of vaccines, immunizations, and other medications from Cass County Health Department.
- 4. The money in said Fund shall be deposited into the county operating account established at Logansport Savings Bank.
