

CASS COUNTY COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-20

ORDINANCE CREATING A PRETRIAL RESEARCH STUDY  
NON-REVERTING FUND

WHEREAS, Cass County maintains a successful Court and Pretrial Services Program which has served as a model for other such programs in the State of Indiana and throughout the country.

WHEREAS, Cass County will be participating in the Intentional Pretrial Supervision Research Study with George Mason University.

WHEREAS, in conjunction with Cass County Court and Pretrial Services participating as a partner in the Intentional Pretrial Supervision Research Study, Cass County will receive participation support funding totaling approximately thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00), over the course of the study.

WHEREAS, the Cass County Council desires that the funding received by Cass County Pretrial Services should be deposited into a non-reverting fund for the designated use of Cass County's Court and Pretrial Services Program.


WHEREAS, that the Cass County Council finds that there is a need to establish such non-reverting fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CASS COUNTY COUNCIL  
AS FOLLOWS:


1. This ordinance creates a non-reverting fund (Pretrial Research Study Non-Reverting Fund #4000) for funding received from participating in the Intentional Pretrial Supervision Research Study.
2. The monies in said Fund shall remain in said Fund # 4000 until expended and shall not revert to the County's General Fund at the end of the county's fiscal year.
3. The monies in said Fund #4000 shall be utilized to pay expenses incurred by Court & Pretrial Services related to services provided in the Program.

Passed and adopted by the County Council of Cass County, Indiana this 15 day of November 2024.






