- IV. NEW BUSINESS
 - A. **Introduction of CEPP, Center for Effective Public Policy**, Denise Symdon and Cynthia Mausser, for JRAC support on Zoom. They observed our meeting today and will continue to provide support and guidance to our JRAC. They plan to observe an upcoming full board meeting as well.
 - B. **John Schellenberger, Commissioner**: Floyd County has had a contract with Blue River Services for transportation from the rural areas to rural areas and to urban areas since late 2022. Discussion regarding current and future use of this program. The Commissioners renewed the contract with Blue River. Discussion and collaboration amongst the group including how we might all benefit and use this service. The services are for rural to urban or urban to rural but not urban to urban. Health Dept. also has bus passes to share with any agency that needs them. Email Charlotte for more info.
 - C. We discussed the option of whether we need more full JRAC meetings and the consensus of the group was to keep meetings as scheduled since it has worked well for us thus far.
 - D. **Charlotte Bass, Health Dept.** notifies group of grant received to fund mental health. They will be partnering with a mental health provider to provide mental health treatment beginning January 1, 2025. They also will be funding dental needs with grant funding of \$50,000.

 - A. Connie Moon – MH and Addiction Resource Support Work Group. Application form and Rubric is completed and has been approved by Commissioners. We set a deadline of 8/6/2024 at 4pm to accept applications. Charlotte at Health Dept. will also accept applications if anyone wants to submit in printed form. We will call a Special Meeting of full JRAC on 9/9/2024 at Noon to vote on the recommendations to be made to the Commissioners from the applications. Connie and her work group will review all the applications and make recommendations to the full board at the special meeting.  - B. Denise Beckwith, Juvenile Initiatives Work Group. They have a meeting this week and are proceeding forward despite the departure of Dr. Brillwater from the school system. They are hoping this does not cause a delay to their work but will keep us posted.
