ADDENDUM TO ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CONSOLIDATED FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FOR LAFAYETTE AND GREENVILLE TOWNSHIPS, FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA, AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF FIRE DISTRICT TRUSTEES FOR THE HIGHLANDER FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FCO 2022-41

WHEREAS, the Highlander Fire Protection District has requested, and the Floyd County Commissioners have agreed, to expand the authority of the Highlander Fire Protection District to include Emergency Medical Services, as defined in I.C. § 16-18-2-110, to be hereafter included as a provision of "Other emergency services" as permitted under Section 1(D) of Ordinance No. FCO 2022-41.

WHEREAS, the provision of Emergency Medical Services, including but not limited to Ambulance Services, shall not exceed the jurisdiction of the fire district, except as otherwise provided by valid mutual aid agreement(s) or necessity, or as otherwise provided by this Ordinance.

WHEREAS, Highlander Fire Protection District's provision of such services shall be done by qualified personnel, and shall be rendered only using the resources of the first district to pay for all primary and ancillary services, unless otherwise agreed by the Floyd County Council.

WHEREAS, it is the intent that the Floyd County Commissioners will be reviewing the fire protection and emergency medical safety needs of the jurisdiction of Floyd County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Commissioners of Floyd County, Indiana, that:

- Authorization: Highlander Fire Protection District is authorized to provide Emergency Medical Services, including but not limited to Ambulance Services, to those in their jurisdiction, or in such jurisdictions as may otherwise be entitled to services by way of necessity or mutual agreement.
- 2. This Ordinance repeals and replaces FCO 2024-12.
