## **Mayor Goodnight Dispatch Presentation**

The committee received a hard copy of the Mayor's presentation plus articles from the Ford Foundation, Howey Politics, USA Today and the New York Times supporting his presentation.

The following are highlights from his presentation:

- Tax revenue is down from declines in population, jobs, school enrollment
- We need long term changes, not short term fixes
- What to do with services?
- Need to start with a clean slate
- Economic stability and growth require city and non-city residents to work together
- Dispatch budget information
- Solution 1: Sheriff takes over all dispatch services
- Solution 2: Consolidated dispatch for entire county

## **Greg Lake MS4 Presentation**

Greg presented the history of MS4 and there were many questions from the committee regarding cost savings opportunities.

## **John Floyd Motion**

John made a motion to have the 911 Dispatch and MS4 personnel update or rework the proposals to reflect the current situation. The committee was interested in the people who
