Judge Shepard presented the request of additional appropriation, she explains she wants her Court Reporters pay to be increased to the same level as other Court Reporters across the board.

COUNTY GENERAL FUND 1000 | Election 0062

Clerk Debbie Stewart presented the request of additional appropriation for equipment for the election at \$87,400. She currently has \$10,000.00 in her equipment line and another \$50,000 she received in Grant money that will go towards the 20 new express voting machines that will be operational for the upcoming November election.

LIT - SPECIAL PURPOSE FUND 1114 | Jail 0380

Sheriff Jerry Asher presented a few things to the Council. First being an increase in the Corrections Officer budget now that they are staffed at 45, but they still need to have a total of 50, Sheriff requested to hire 5 more people which would bring him up to 50 Correctional Officers. Councilman Faulkner made a motion to approve the request as is presented with that \$76,601.60 representing the hire of potentially five new Correctional Officer Councilwoman Lake seconded the motion, the motion carried. Sheriff Jerry Asher also presented a request of an Additional Appropriation for \$275,000.00. The Council only approved \$200,000.00 for overtime. Lastly, Sheriff Jerry Asher requested an additional appropriation for \$2,500.00 to compensate for a new employee who was a lateral transfer from the prison. He will also need \$195.00 to cover FICA costs for this position.

COUNTY USER FEE FUND: 2542

Community Corrections Director Dustin Delong requested an additional appropriation for \$30,000 in the Meal Reimbursement Fund for work release.

JCC PSC GRANT: 9103 GRANT

Juvenile Assistant Chief Probations Officer Connie Burton presents the Grants awarded, one is for the Juvenile Problem-Solving Court that's the \$77,600.00. This covers PSC Case Manager, Juvenile Referee, Drug Screening, Curriculum, and incentives.

JDAI GRANT: 9212 Grant

Juvenile Assistant Chief Probations Officer Connie Burton also presents the JDAI Grant they were awarded in the amount of \$7,461.82. This covers Office supplies, travel, training, and other supplies.
