### IN THE MATTER OF NEW BUSINESS:

#### US 31 PEL Study - IINTB

Cassidy Hunter Communications manager for Propel US31 was joined by Dan Miller. They both came to present the Draft Level 2 screening report and provide resources for information. Cassidy stated, the alternatives Screening process has completed their first step of a three-step process, they are currently on Level 2. The reason for Level 2 purpose is to qualitatively evaluate location specific improvement for reasonability and impacts. They found 14 opportunities, that were primary intersections, such as access points for schools, emergency service providers, and agricultural equipment. This has four steps being a decision tree, traffic operations analysis, qualitative evaluation matrix, and the conceptual footprint. Five primary concepts that made it through the screening were, access management, unsignalized intersection improvements, crossroad overpasses and underpasses, act grade intersections to interchanges, and free flow facilities. Cassidy stated that the information that was presented today can be found on their website.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, the meeting was adjourned at 4:53 p.m. on a motion made by Councilman Faulkner.
